- *Floral Section please provide a water source that will last the show*
- *The theme Bubbles will also be voted on by the public*

- *Potted plants must be grown by the exhibitor for at least (6) six months prior to the show.*
- *Pot size maximum 400mm*
- *Please bring tray or saucer under the pot to protect cloths*

SECTION R

- 1 One Bloom - Red/Crimson
- 2 One Bloom - White/Cream
- 3 One Bloom - Bi-colour/Tricolour
- 4 One Bloom Any Other Colour Rose
- 5 One Bloom- Full blown rose, Stamens must show.
- 6 One Bloom- Single flowered Rose (No more than 7 petals)
- 7 One Bloom- David Austin /Old Fashioned Rose
- 8 One Stem- Cluster- flowered
- 9 One Bloom - Pink/Rose
- 10 One Bloom - Yellow/Apricot
- 11 One Container- Cluster-Flowered Rose
- 12 One Container- Roses of Mixed Variety
